What is Snapchat?

Snapchat is a messaging app where users can create messages, known as "snaps", which can come in the form of a short video, a photo, or text. Snaps can be sent directly to contacts within the app, or uploaded to a story feed, available for 24 hours after upload. Snaps are easy to customise, letting users add filters, special effects, drawings, and captions. Snapchat's features also allow for location sharing with the "Snap Map".
