Title: Limudei Kodesh Teaching Assistant

Responsible to: Head of Limudei Kodesh & Headteacher

Role Purpose

To support the delivery of high-quality Limudei Kodesh education across the school by working under the direction of Limudei Kodesh teachers and senior leaders. The post holder will provide educational, pastoral and practical support to pupils, contribute to Jewish life within the school and assist with the organisation of key Jewish experiences and events.

Professional Responsibilities

1. To support Limudei Kodesh teachers in the delivery of lessons and learning activities, working with individuals, small groups or whole classes as directed.
2. To model and promote the school's Jewish ethos, values and expectations at all times.
3. To contribute positively to the wider life of the school, particularly in relation to Jewish practice, celebrations and communal experiences.
4. To carry out any other reasonable duties commensurate with the role, as directed by the Head of Limudei Kodesh or Headteacher.

Teaching and Learning Support

1. Support pupils' learning in Limudei Kodesh lessons, including listening to pupils read Hebrew and supporting reading fluency and comprehension.
2. Deliver regular Hebrew Reading interventions under the guidance of the Limudei Kodesh team.
3. Work with individual pupils or small groups to reinforce learning, pre-teach vocabulary or consolidate key skills.
4. Assist teachers in preparing resources and learning materials.
5. Support classroom organisation and contribute to maintaining a purposeful and respectful learning environment.
6. Cover Limudei Kodesh lessons when required, following provided plans and under the direction of senior staff.

Jewish Life and Tefillah

1. Lead Tefillah for year groups, as directed.
2. Lead Benschung with pupils at appropriate times.
3. Support pupils in developing confidence and participation in Tefillah.

Whole-School Jewish Events and Experiences

1. Help to organise and support whole-school celebrations for Chagim, including preparation, logistics and pupil participation.

2. Assist in the organisation and delivery of Chagigat HaSiddur and Chagigat HaChumash.
3. Attend and help to organise the annual Year 5 school Shabbaton.
4. Attend and help to organise the Year 6 Residential, supporting pupils' wellbeing, engagement and participation.

Pupils and Pastoral Support

1. Support pupils' emotional, social and religious development in line with the school's values.
2. Promote positive behaviour and assist teachers in maintaining high standards of conduct.
3. Attend to pupils' basic welfare needs in line with school policies.

Communication and Working with Others

1. Work collaboratively with Limudei Kodesh staff, support staff and the wider school team.
2. Communicate effectively with teachers regarding pupil progress, engagement and any concerns.
3. Maintain professional relationships with pupils, parents and colleagues.

Safeguarding and Professional Conduct

1. Promote and safeguard the welfare of all pupils.
2. Adhere to all school safeguarding, behaviour and health & safety policies.
3. Act as a positive Jewish role model at all times.

Working Time and Review

This job description sets out the main expectations of the school in relation to the post holder's professional responsibilities and duties. It is not a comprehensive statement of procedures and tasks and may be reviewed annually and amended as required, following consultation with the post holder.
